Pinky = 4

Nevertheless, if you build the Harmonic Minor scale starting on it's fifth it becomes the "HARMONIC MINOR OF DESTINATION" commonly called "MHD" for a "V7(b9)" chord. We use that chord when it's destination is V7 / III and V7 / VI
